Explosion.	a) Gas leakage. b) Refuelling generators. c) Improper use of gas cylinders. d) Appliances lit whilst vehicles in motion.	a) Never refuel generators when running or hot. b) Train all persons on correct use of LPG. c) Don't carry more than necessary cylinders. d) Don't store / carry large amount of petrol diesel or gas	a) Electrical and gas compliance certificates. b) Visual checks. c) Training register. d) Accident record.
Towing.	a) Incorrect loading of trailers. b) Towing vehicle / trailer weight ratio incorrect.	a) Distribute load properly. b) Do not exceed manufacturers max GLW.	a) Towing vehicle and trailer loading weight information b) Check nose weight. c) Take trailer to weigh bridge with typical load. d) Accident record.
